

Victorian Voices – Rules

1. All submitted entries must be the work of pupils within the stated age categories. Either:
Category 1: Y3/4 (Eng, Wales, NI and Republic of Ire) and P4/5 (Scotland)
Category 2: Y5/6 (Eng, Wales, NI and Republic of Ire) and P6/7 (Scotland)
2. All entries must be the result of work which has taken place in the school stated on the entry cover sheet.
3. Entries should be no longer than 600 words.
4. Entries will be accepted in the following formats: hand written, word-processed, voice recorded on cassette or CD.
5. If submitting an entry for a child with special educational needs please note the appropriate reading age in the space provided on the cover sheet. The entry will then be judged in the appropriate category.
6. By competing in Victorian Voices consent is given for the use of entries in publicity material.
7. To enable impartiality in the judging process please ensure that the name of the entrant does not appear on the short story (either on a written or voice recorded entry).
8. The judges' decision is final.
9. Prizes for both winning schools and individual children will be sent directly to schools following the announcement of winners in March 2006.
10. The closing date for the competition is 21 December 2005.
